



Slovenian Research Agency (ARRS) – Austrian Science Fund (FWF)

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Joint Projects

The Austrian Science Fund (FWF) and the Slovenian Research Agency/Javna agencija za raziskovalno dejavnost Republike Slovenije (ARRS) jointly offer the possibility to apply for bilateral Slovenian-Austrian Joint Research Projects. The project parts should be **closely integrated** and there should be **scientific input** from both sides. Applications will be dealt with following the **Lead Agency Principle**. In order to find out which of the two funding agencies will act as the Lead Agency, applicants should calculate the **direct costs** of the two project parts beforehand. The application/project description must be submitted **only** to the research funding organization at **which the larger financial share will be applied for**. This research funding organization in the sequel acts as the Lead Agency, **carries out the review process** and makes a funding suggestion. The application must be prepared **in accordance with the formal guidelines of the Lead Agency**. The Lead Agency is in charge of carrying out the peer review procedure. Projects can have a **maximum duration of three years**. In addition, applicants have to send the **application forms** to the second funding agency involved (for details cf. below). **All fields of basic research** are eligible.

Project duration: 3 years

When to apply?

FWF acts as Lead Agency (Austrian project part is more expensive than the Slovenian part)

⇒ Submission possible any time

ARRS acts as Lead Agency (Slovenian project part is more expensive than the Austrian part)

⇒ Proposals must be submitted to the **annual ARRS call** for research projects. (Please check <u>www.arrs.si</u> for details)

How to apply?

ARRS acts as Lead Agency

Proposal/Project description is submitted to ARRS in the framework of its annual call for research projects, following the application guidelines of ARRS. ARRS follows a two-stage evaluation procedure:

1st stage (draft proposal stage):

The draft proposal is submitted to ARRS according to ARRS guidelines. Austrian applicants need not inform FWF at this stage.

Important note: Should the financial focus shift between the 1st and 2nd application stage, this leads to a change of the Lead Agency from ARRS to FWF. In the sequel, the application would have to be submitted to FWF according to FWF guidelines. Applicants are thus advised to carefully consider the budget calculations already before submitting a draft proposal (1st stage) to ARRS.

2nd Stage (full proposal stage):

For Austrian applicants the eligibility criteria as well as the cost guidelines for "stand-alone projects" ("Einzelprojekte") as published in January 2015 apply.

Austrian applicants must send only the following documents <u>directly to FWF</u> (<u>hard copy and on</u> CD-Rom):

- FWF application forms for international collaborative projects (application form + form "programme specific data" + form "coauthors" + cost sheet; other forms such as for scientific equipment only if applicable; the FWF forms can be downloaded here)
- Abstracts (in accordance with <u>FWF</u> guidelines, cf. p.2)

Alternatively, this information can be **submitted online** via https://elane.fwf.ac.at (program category "I – International Programs").

FWF acts as Lead Agency

Proposal/Project description is submitted to FWF, following the <u>application guidelines of FWF standalone projects</u> ("Einzelprojekte") *as published in April 2016.*

Applications can be submitted **anytime**. The FWF application forms can be downloaded <u>here</u>.

Proposals can be sent by **mail** (FWF, Sensengasse 1, 1090 Wien) **or** they can be **submitted online** (https://elane.fwf.ac.at; program category "I – International Programs").

Applications to FWF must include additional information on:

- The **distribution of work** between the partners
- the **added value** of the co-operation
- separate budget justifications for the Austrian and the Slovenian part (both for personnel and non-personnel costs)

For Slovenian applicants eligibility criteria and fund limits apply (cf.
