ERC Advanced Grant: Overview

- Can be in any field of research, evaluation based on excellence
- Supports individual researchers who are already established research leaders with a recognised track record of research achievements (specifically in the last 10 years)
- 10 years Track record: to demonstrate PI's exceptional leadership in terms of originality and significance of research contributions; appropriate to the field of research, also covers innovation, leadership, training of researchers. Can be extended if documented breaks.
- Research idea: original, innovative, ground-breaking, bridging a research gap => advance the state of the art
- Should “stand alone” and not aim for incremental advancements in the field
- Must be ambitious in scope and risk but also feasible. Risk in the idea, not in the implementation

ERC Advanced Grant: Budget

- PIs can request up to 2.5 million EUR for up to 5 years (additional budget of 1 million EUR can be requested for PIs moving to Europe, major equipment, major experimental/fieldwork costs)
- Team: PI + recruited team at Univie. If justified, can also include a collaborator in another institution. But it's *not* a collaborative project!

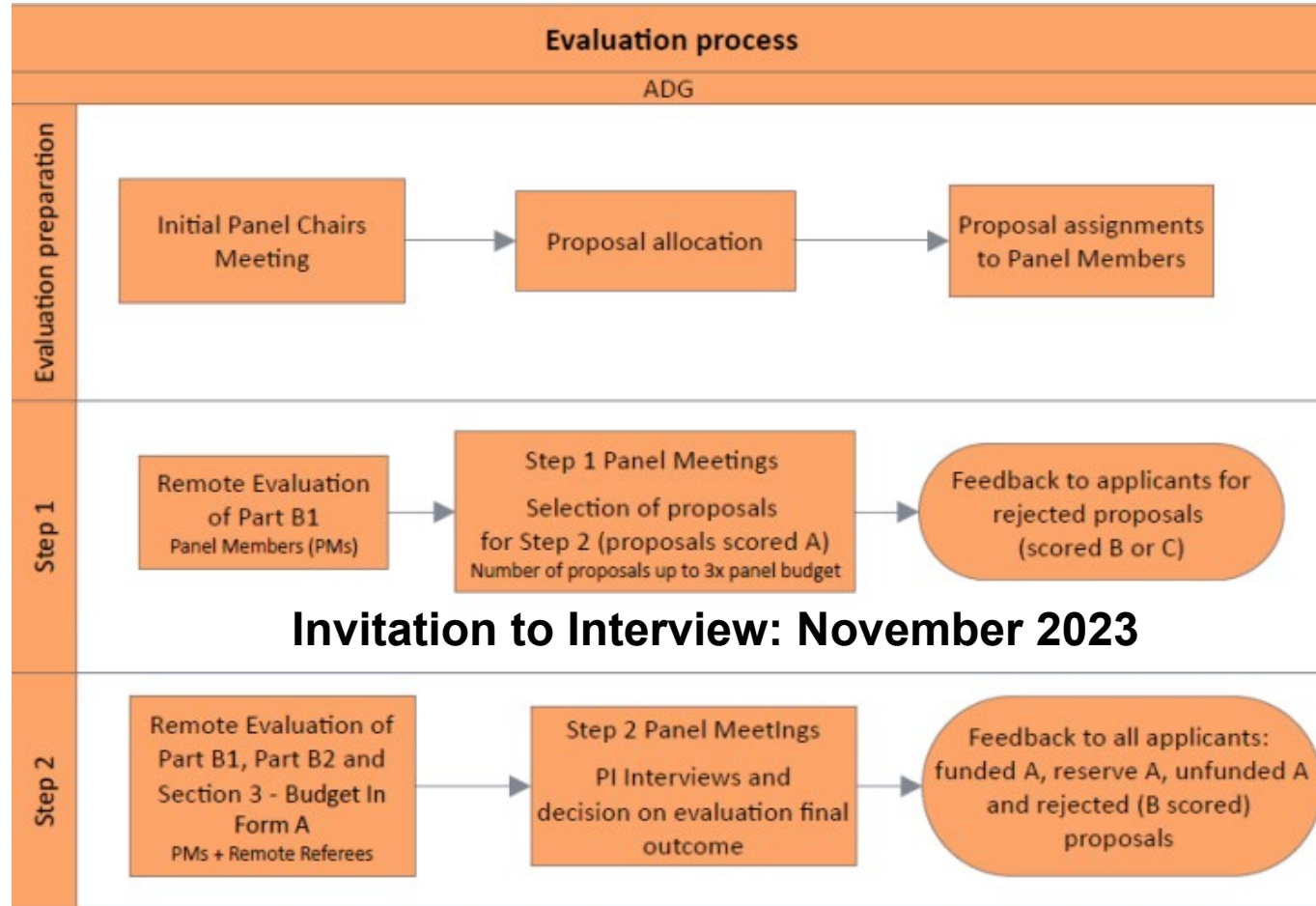
