1 New process and responsibilities



New process for FWF funding

- New as of 2024-01-01: FWF Open Access funding (peer-reviewed publications) processed directly via the <u>Open Access Office</u> of the University of Vienna.
- The FWF provides financial support to the University via the <u>"OA block grant"</u>.







The FWF Open Access policy still applies! OA funding for "peer-reviewed book publications": remains with the FWF



What changes in terms of FWF OA funding?

2 FWF funding requirements



FWF OA Policy: Principles for peer-reviewed publications

- Publications resulting from FWF projects must be published Open Access (FWF mandate for OA).
- OA has to be implemented using the <u>CC BY licence</u>. (other CC licences such as e.g. CC BY-NC or CC BY-ND are not compliant).
- OA has to happen at the date of publication (<u>immediate OA</u>).
- Gold OA (OA on the publisher's platform) and Green OA (OA via repository) are possible.
- Acknowledgement and Rights Retention Statement has to be included in every submission.

Acknowledgement and Rights Retention Statement

The following text must be included in all publications on submission:

"This research was funded in whole or in part by the Austrian Science Fund (FWF) [grant DOI]. For open access purposes, the author has applied a CC BY public copyright license to any author accepted manuscript version arising from this submission."

> CC (1) Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0)

Free to:

Share — copy and redistribute the material in any medium or format

Adapt — remix, transform, and build upon the material for any purpose, even commercially.

FWF funding requirements I

OA charges are covered for contributions in:



- ✓ Gold OA Journals (Fully OAJ) listed in DOAJ.org
- Subscription journals (Hybrid OAJ), inside OA publishing agreements
- Peer-reviewed proceedings

Eligible authors:

- Only <u>corresponding authors¹</u> are covered (not co-authors)
- Corresponding authors have to be University affiliates²⁾

1) *Corresponding author* is the person the publisher is in contact with concerning the article and who is named as such in the publication itself.

2) University affiliates are persons as per UG 2002 §94 at the respective relevant date (submission/acceptance/application; details see funding requirements on our website).



FWF funding requirements II

Charges are not covered for:

- Publications in subscription journals (Hybrid OA) outside of publishing agreements.
- Submission charges, page charges, colour charges, cover charges ...
- Publications bearing licences other than CC BY*
- Delayed or retroactive OA*

Funding requirements

- The "corresponding author"¹) of the article is affiliated²) with the University of Vienna on the date of acceptance.
- The "corresponding author" states "University of Vienna" as their affiliation or as one of their affiliations in the article.
- Article types covered: OriginalPaper, ReviewPaper, BriefCommunication oder ContinuingEducation. Book reviews are always excluded from funding.
- The following applies to articles resulting from EU projects: funding can currently be provided by the University of Vienna (sufficient remaining articles available).

FWF projects: OA funding processed by UniVie. Additional requirements:

- Required licence: CC BY
- The following passage must be included in all publications at submission: This research was funded in whole or in part by the Austrian Science Fund (FWF) [grant DOI]. For open access purposes, the author has applied a CC BY public copyright license to any author accepted manuscript version arising from this submission.

Funding is only provided for Open Access (Article Processing Charges, APCs), not for any additional fees (e.g. colour charges, submission fees).
